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### Day 1.

We flew from London Gatwick (LGW) to Palma airport (PMI) with easyJet arriving for approx 2PM on Monday.

- cold foods; cheese, meats, cereal, fruit and yoghurt
- hot foods; mini chorizo sausages, scrambled egg, fried egg, bacon, tomato and beans
- bakery selection; mini crossiant, mini ensaimada and mini pain au chocolat

We proceeded to the Bellver castle as our hotel was conveniently close. The castle was only €4 each and was well worth doing as it let you learn about the history (available in English) and had a beautiful view of all of Palma from the top. It was not incredibly busy but there were some school groups there at the time.
